BAIS Athletics “No Pass, No Play Policy”

1. Students who begin a sporting season on academic probation will be permitted to participate for one quarter or until the next mid-term report or semester report cards are issued. At that time, if the student still qualifies for academic probation, he will be required to step down from his team immediately and will not be permitted to play any sport from that point forward until he is out of academic probation. Note: #1 is conditional with #2-4.
2. Athletes on academic probation are required to have a grade report completed by their teachers every week during the sports season. An example of this report is given below. The Athletic Director is required to collect these reports from students and turn them in to the school Director by Tuesday of each week. The Athletic Director will meet weekly with the school Director to present and discuss these reports. The purpose of this weekly report is to act as a monitor until grade reports are issued. If it is apparent that a student is not improving his/her grades or is failing one or more subjects, action will be taken immediately, and the student will not be permitted to continue playing sports. Also, a student’s class participation and attitude will be taken into consideration. If a considerable drop in this category occurs and academics are also in question, the student will be required to stop playing sports immediately.

3. Whether a student is currently on academic probation or not, if a grade of “F” appears on any progress report or report card, the student will immediately be removed from sports and not be permitted to join again until all “F”s are raised and the student is no longer on academic probation.
4. On non-practice days, students are still required to attend academic probation sessions. If a student fails to show up for academic probation one time, the student will be required to stop playing sports immediately and will not be permitted to play any sport from that point forward until being removed from academic probation.

Final Note: The office of the Director reserves the right to override these guidelines at any time. The BAIS school policy is that when a student is on academic probation no athletics participation is permitted. The above guidelines are used when considering an exception. Exceptions will only be considered by petition of the Athletic Director. It is the responsibility of the Athletic Director to solicit and communicate to the faculty that a particular student is being considered and determine if they have any objections to that request.
