## Vaccination News



Thank you to all the parents who came with or sent your students to the hospital to get their vaccinations. The hospital was gracious and did not charge most of us for their administration cost or nursing costs for the injections. They also had special clinic times from 3-5pm for just our students. For those families that did not have an opportunity to go during this last week to the special clinic (more than half of the students), RS Cahya Kawalayaan nurses are still available during 8-2pm in the pediatric clinic to give

immunizations that are needed. Just bring your child's immunization check list that was sent to you. The basic charge for immunizations will be the same, but you will be charged an administration fee of Rp. 5000 for first time patient card and Rp. 10,000-14,000 for nurse to give injection.

If you have misplaced the check list, please email [Devlynneveux@baisedu.org](mailto:Devlynneveux@baisedu.org) and I will send you the required immunizations for your student. You will need to get these done before June or your child's report card will be held. If you are waiting until the summer to get immunizations in your home country, please let me know so I can put a note on your child's chart. **No one will be allowed to start school next year without having completed all immunizations that are required**, including boosters for middle school and high school students. As you complete the list, please send proof of injections given which include a note from your doctor or hospital so it can be added to update your students file.
