Dear BAIS Community -

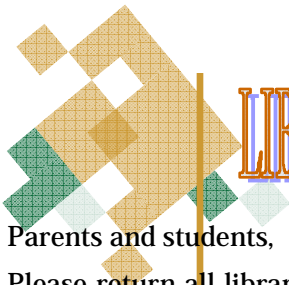
