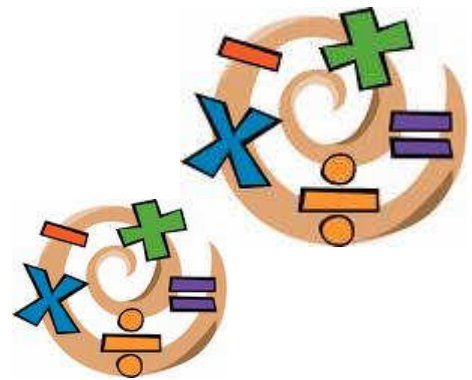

FOR 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

The due date for the Re-enrollment (along with the non-refundable re-enrollment fee of US\$ 100.00 per student) is Friday, March 12, 2010. Due to the Indonesian bank policy, we can only accept H series dollars issued in 2006. Please note after March 12, 2010 your child's seat in class is no longer secure. Various classes are full or near full so please re-enroll right away before March 12, 2010. The US\$ 100.00 non-refundable re-enrollment fee will be applied towards the student's fall 2010 tuition. After March 12, 2010, only US\$ 50.00 of the US\$ 100.00 will be applied towards the student's fall 2010 tuition.
