UPDATE ON IMMUNIZATIONS



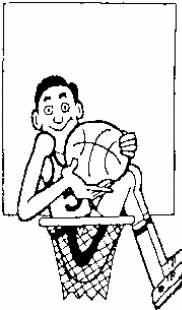
About half of the BAIS students are caught up on their immunizations!!! For the half that are not, this is a serious matter that we are trying to correct. Parents, please follow through with completing the vaccinations that were recommended on the letter that was sent out 2 months ago. If you have misplaced the letter and don't remember what immunizations your student(s) need, please email me. Some students have been sick, others wanted to wait until they go home to finish their vaccinations. I am especially concerned about the students that are leaving and will be trying to get into schools in their home countries. I have prepared an official

"certification of vaccination" form that I can compile all the dates for immunizations that have been given for seniors and non-returning students. Please send me an email if you want one of these forms.

It is the parent's responsibility to contact me before June 14th to see if your student(s) are caught up on immunizations. Returning students will not be allowed to return next school year (August 2010) without having completed their immunizations. devlynneveux@baisedu.org
