March is vaccination month!!! We are half way through the month and many students have come into my office to let me know they received their immunizations. Thank you to the parents that have caught their children up on their immunizations. Please don't forget to get me the documentation from the doctor or hospital that shows the name of the vaccine given and the date. For those parents and students that have not finished updating their immunizations, the hospital has scheduled a special vaccination clinic next Wednesday from 3-5pm for BAIS students. They have requested that I give them a list of which students are coming and which vaccines are needed. If you are interested in having your students going after school next week to the RS Cahya Kawaluyan in Kota Baru to finish their immunizations, **please let me know so the hospital can order the correct amount of each vaccine.** They are currently out of Hepatitis A, but have it on order to be ready for Wednesday the 24th for those who register with me (Devlyn) in the clinic. The price list is below and the money will be due to the hospital on Wednesday the same time students get their immunization.

1. Haprix (Hepatitis A)	285.000
2. MMR(measles, mumps, rubella)	110.000 *66.000 (child-<15 y/o)
3. Euvax / Engerix (Hepatitis B)	*105.000 (adult->= 15 y/o)
4. Polio	15.000
5. Typhim (typhoid)	110.000
6. DT	20.000
7. DPT	25.000

IISSAC BOYS STORY



I'll give a brief wrap up of our regular season, and the IISSAC tournament. The BAIS Eagles Boy's Varsity team went 8-4 in the regular season, with losses to very tough teams (JIS, SMA 9 2x, ITHB university). I'm proud of the way our boys played during the season, usually keeping their emotions in check, playing hard and playing for an Audience of One. They played exciting ball, fast and fast-breaking at every opportunity. I'll give the five top scorers and rebounders per game on the varsity team:

Scoring: Matt M (17.7), Won Jin (11.4), Terry (9.8), Yoon Seong (6.1), Min Young (3.8)

Rebounding: Matt M (10.8), Terry (8.2), Matt L (5.2), Won Jin (4.8), Keun (3.3)

Matt Marshall also led the team in assists, steals, blocks and shooting percentage. Drew and Brady were an important part of the team, showing great team spirit and attitude. Paul and Luke Marshall also saw some playing time, especially at IISSAC, and got good experience for next year.

At the IISSAC tournament, the Eagles won the first three games by an average of 33 points, with Matt M, Terry and Won Jin leading the way on offense and defense. . The now infamous food poisoning began to effect several of the boys during the second game (and on through the night and next morning), but they continued to play well and all eleven players saw action. We faced a very inspired Mountain View team in the finals. Our boys played their hearts out, but in the end it wasn't enough, as BAIS lost 26-32. It was a learning experience for the boys to deal with disappointment and adverse conditions. Won Jin was voted to the all star team, and Matt Marshall won the Most Outstanding Player of the tournament.
