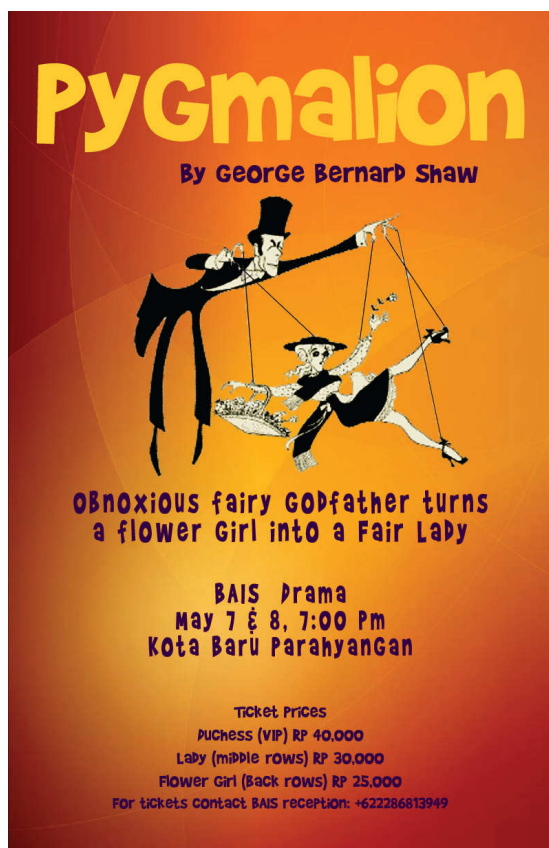

- Old Fashioned Clock

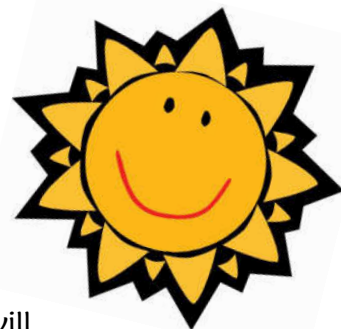
