Pre-season swimming...



Swimmers will be able to start conditioning with supervised lap swimming starting Tuesday February 9th dependant upon securing a pool. The preseason sessions are optional for swimmers that can swim a minimum of 100 meters with out stopping. Additionally, swimmers must pay an entry fee at the time of the practice. Swimmers that make the team on March 12th will be charged 1 juta for the season including IISSAC tournament expenses and will be reimbursed for per-season practices that they attended. We are also looking for opportunities for our younger and weaker swimmers. More details coming next week.

SWIM COACH CLASS: We have invited a Swim Australia instructor to teach a 6 hour certification class on Saturday March 6th.
