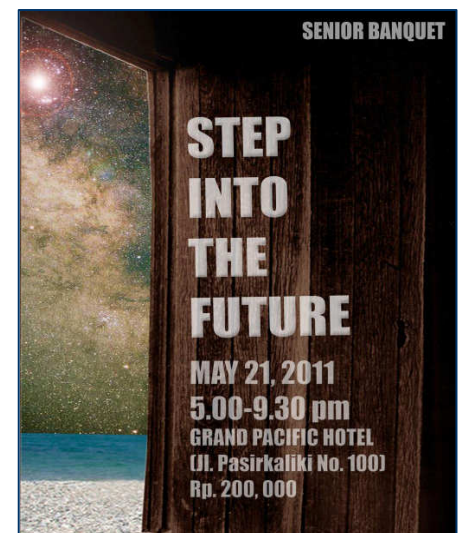
## Senior Banquet 2011
