Dear parents,

Today you will be receiving an email survey regarding our Language Arts program at BAIS. This survey is part of our curriculum review cycle. This year we are beginning a three year review of our Language Arts classes i.e. reading, writing, speaking, and listening. This first year is called the evaluation year. This is where we gather information on our strengths and areas of needed improvement within that subject. Next year is the examination year. We look at all the data and come up with an action plan on how to improve the program. This could involve purchasing new textbooks and resources. It could mean changing class schedules or offering different classes. It may even involve new training for the teachers. The third and final year of the review is the implementation year. This is the year we begin using the new resources, and we implement the new decisions that were put in place over the last two research years. Our ultimate goal is to continue to strengthen and improve our overall program at BAIS. The BAIS curriculum review cycle allows for every subject to be reviewed within a 6 year rotation.

Reenrollment Reminder

Please complete the reenrollment form and return it with the appropriate fees to the BAIS office on or before **Friday, March 3, 2017**. The reenrollment form can be collected in the school office and on the school website. Your child's reenrollment for the **2017-2018** school year is secure when this form and the accompanying payment have been received. Payment can be made by bank transfer or cash to the finance office.

Please note after March 3, 2017 your child's seat in class is no longer secure. Some classes are close to their student limit, so please reenroll promptly to ensure your student's seat. The 7,000,000 IDR non-refundable reenrollment deposit will be applied towards the student's fall 2016 tuition. After March 3, 2017, only 5,500,000 IDR of the 7,000,000 IDR deposit will be applied towards the student's fall 2017 tuition.
