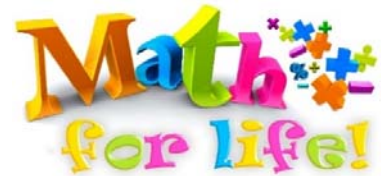


2018 Christmas Performance: A White Top and White Bottom
