BAIS has made some changes over the past few years with regard to tuition and the financial calendar. I just want to express my thanks to all of you for your patience and understanding as we have made these transitions. I also have been extremely encouraged by our community response to our recent marketing efforts and for your participation in them. We truly have a great community and I count it a privilege to be a part of it! Below are some data and reminders about these recent changes

REENROLLMENT - 94% of our families (those who know they will be in the Bandung area next year) have already paid the re enrolment deposit for 2019-2020, and many of the other 6% have indicated they intend to do so. Thank you for continuing to trust us to partner with you! Additionally, we have 22 enrolled and/or in process new students for next year. Please pray for continued inquiries about our program and new students for next year.

DISCOUNTS - BAIS has given 70 juta in discounts just through our referral plan. THANK YOU to all who have been promoting BAIS to your friends and families.

UPCOMING EVENT - As a part of our continued effort to make our name more widely known in Bandung, BAIS will be participating in another Educational Fair at PVJ. We will host a booth and have several of our students perform. Parents were our best representatives last time, and we will need you again! Please keep an eye out for sign-up opportunities.

EARLY BIRD - Please remember the early bird discount dates have been moved. You will receive a 5% discount if you pay in full by March 1st, 2019, and 3% discount if you pay in full by May 3rd, 2019.



Sophomores Andrew and Clifford observed, "We could have done better if we had had Ollie because last time he made a lot of shots. We played really well. We've also been practicing hard and as a result we played better than the first time against CBCS."

Mr. Thomas: "Compared with the boys' first game against CBCS, this game was completely different. In our first game we were down 15-3 at the end of the first quarter and came back to win. This game we were up 8-2 at the start and we were able to preserve that lead throughout. The boys did not have a great game in terms of their shooting percentage, but defense was very strong and it was very rare that CBCS earned offensive rebounds for second-chance points. Paul Walker was strong on the boards and there was a united, strong effort to efficiently break their press defense."

HaYeon and Rachel both scored 4pts; Kyla and Emily each scored 2pts!

Emily said, "We did better than before and we still have room to improve. They were missing #7 and that made a big difference because she made a lot of their layups. But we were missing Beltra last time. Having her this game made a big difference. Beltra did really good and she made a lot of good passes."

Miss Christensen: "The girls worked hard against a strong CBCS team. Due to an injury to our regular point guard, our back-up point guards had to step up and lead the team. They both demonstrated poise under pressure. We saw a lot of good things from the girls, and we are excited to see even more improvement as the season progresses."


