

From the Elementary Principal

As our final few students finish their MAP tests for this term, our team has begun to look at the data these tests have provided. While many have grown and shown high achievement, it was understood ahead of time that some students' scores would reflect the glaring challenges of a turbulent year.



At BAIS, we align with current research that points to elementary students learning best via in-person, experiential, hands-on instruction. The 2020-2021 school year has not afforded much opportunity for this type of learning. We believe that standardized tests in an extremely non-standard year truly do not give us a clear picture of our elementary students' abilities.

Our teachers and administrators (as well as those from schools around the globe) are taking these factors into consideration as we analyze our scores. We consider MAP testing to be quite important, yet view it as one piece of the learning experience at BAIS. Your child's MAP scores will be sent along with this year's final report card, along with helpful information about how to interpret those scores.
